

2020 AUGUST TROPHY General Show Rules

Pre-Entries—A pre entry constitutes an entry that is mailed on the correct entry blank with all the information complete. Registration paper must be presented to the secretary at the time of entry. Papers must be sent for every show. Pre-entries dates are listed on the class list . FAXES AND MESSENGER ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

Post-Entries—A \$25 one time post entry fee will be added if entries are received after the entry date. Post entry fee does not apply to pre-entered horses who add classes at the show.

Performance Halter—You must provide proof of eligibility ROM in order to participate in Performance Halter.

Membership—Anyone wishing to show in an AQHA class must present a current AQHA membership card at the time of entry. Membership can be purchased at the office. An internet receipt from AQHA will NOT be accepted as proof .

Adds and Scratches—Scratches may only be made through the show office and must be at least three classes prior to the class you are scratching. All other scratches will be charged. All closed accounts will not receive a refund. You must add your classes for each day at the office.

Stall Reservations—Stalls are not guaranteed or assigned if not sent with complete payment. Groups wishing to be stabled together MUST send stall money in as a group. Please send a stall trainer form with everyone wishing to be stabled together. Please no phone reservations. Stalls must be vacated and left in a reasonable manner. Any paraphernalia left in stall assigned to you shall constitute a \$100.00 fine. **Stalls are non refundable.**

Refund of Entry—Refunds are only granted if an official Veterinary slip is presented before the start of the first class of the entire show to the show office. Once the Vet slip is received, a \$40.00 office fee per entry and stall shall be deducted and a refund shall be mailed. Stalls are non refundable.

Fines Levied—Please be aware that exhibitors are responsible for fines levied against the show caused by exhibitor. See Rule 414c in the AQHA Handbook.

NSF Fees—A \$35.00 NSF fee shall be added to all payment that are not sufficient.

Open Accounts—Accounts that are not settled before the end of the show shall incur an additional \$15.00 collection fee. Please be sure all accounts are settled within 30 minutes of the last class of the show or the office will settle your account for you.

Draws—All class draws shall be done at least two classes prior. All late entries shall be placed at the end of the draw.

Drug Testing—All horses entering AQHA classes and Futurities are subject to approved drug testing.

Awards—Trophy Circuit—Circuit awards and show bucks shall be given through 5 places in all classes .Trophy Circuit show bucks may be used like cash at the on-site vendors at this show . Show bucks will not be applied to your show bill.

Walk/Trot—No cross entry into lope classes per Division; i.e. if you show in Walk Trot Horsemanship you are not eligible to show in Walk Jog Lope Horsemanship. This does not effect showmanship.

All Breed—These classes are meant to encourage and bring new members to our association .

All-Around—Youth 18 and Under , Walk Trot 11 and Under , Amateur, Select , Level 1 Youth Level 1 Amateur. Scores must be under all judges and shall use the AQHA point system. Exhibitors must show in three categories. Ties will be broken by the horse earning the most points in the greatest number of events, then the horse earning the greatest number of first places, then the winner over the greatest number of horses. High points are calculated on a one horse one rider combination except for Open Horse, multiple handlers are allowed. Walk Trot shall not require 3 categories and will be awarded to the rider with the most points and shall be a different award than the All Arouns .

Circuit Awards— Trophy Circuit you must compete under all judges offered at a show to be eligible for a circuit award. Three entries must show in a class at least one day for the award to qualify for circuit awards.

Right to Service - The show management reserves the right to refuse service for any reason. Dogs are not allowed in the arena and schooling areas due to the extreme danger to injury to horse and riders.

Pro Am Will be calculated by combining the judges scores from the two gos. The highest overall scores shall win. Should there be a tie the highest total Am/Youth scores shall break the tie. Next the highest single Pro score next highest single Am score. Pay-outs per NSBA. A 25.00 per team office fee shall be deducted.

Futurities— Futurities shall follow NSBA rules **but shall not be approved by NSBA, 80% Payback on entry fees for all futurities**-Open and Non Pro futurities are 100.00 The owners membership must match the name on the registration papers presented. Non Pro exhibitors must possess Non Pro or Amateur cards in their respective Divisions. WSQHA membership is required for owner and rider to compete in all Futurities. Membership may be purchased at the show office. All prize money is subject to placing audits and clearing of method of payment. Checks will be disbursed after 21 days and only with receipt of a Social Security number. Checks will be held until all information and payment is in order. The futurities are open to registered Paints, Pintos, Buckskin, Palomino, Appaloosas and Quarter Horses. All exhibitors, trainers and staff associated with the futurity horse will abide will abide by the show and WSQHA rules. Futurity entries close at 10:00a.m. on the day of futurities. Once entered, no refunds will be granted.
