7. Back one horse length and sitting trot to the exit

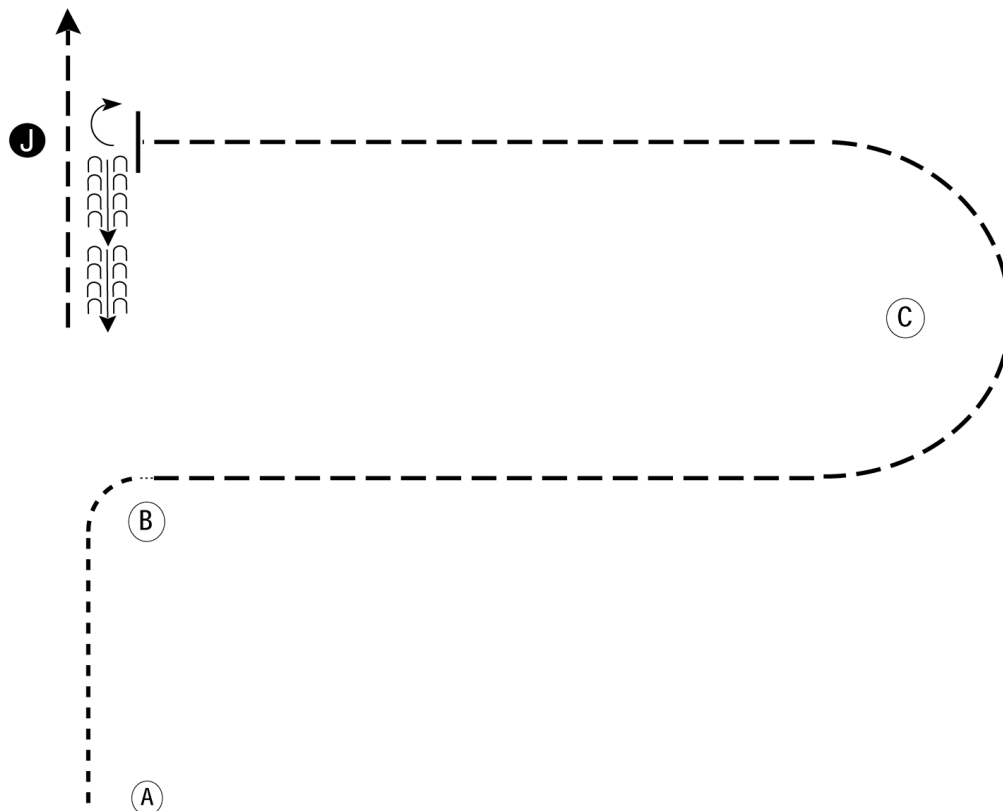

6. Perform a 1 3/4 turn and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, exit at a walk.

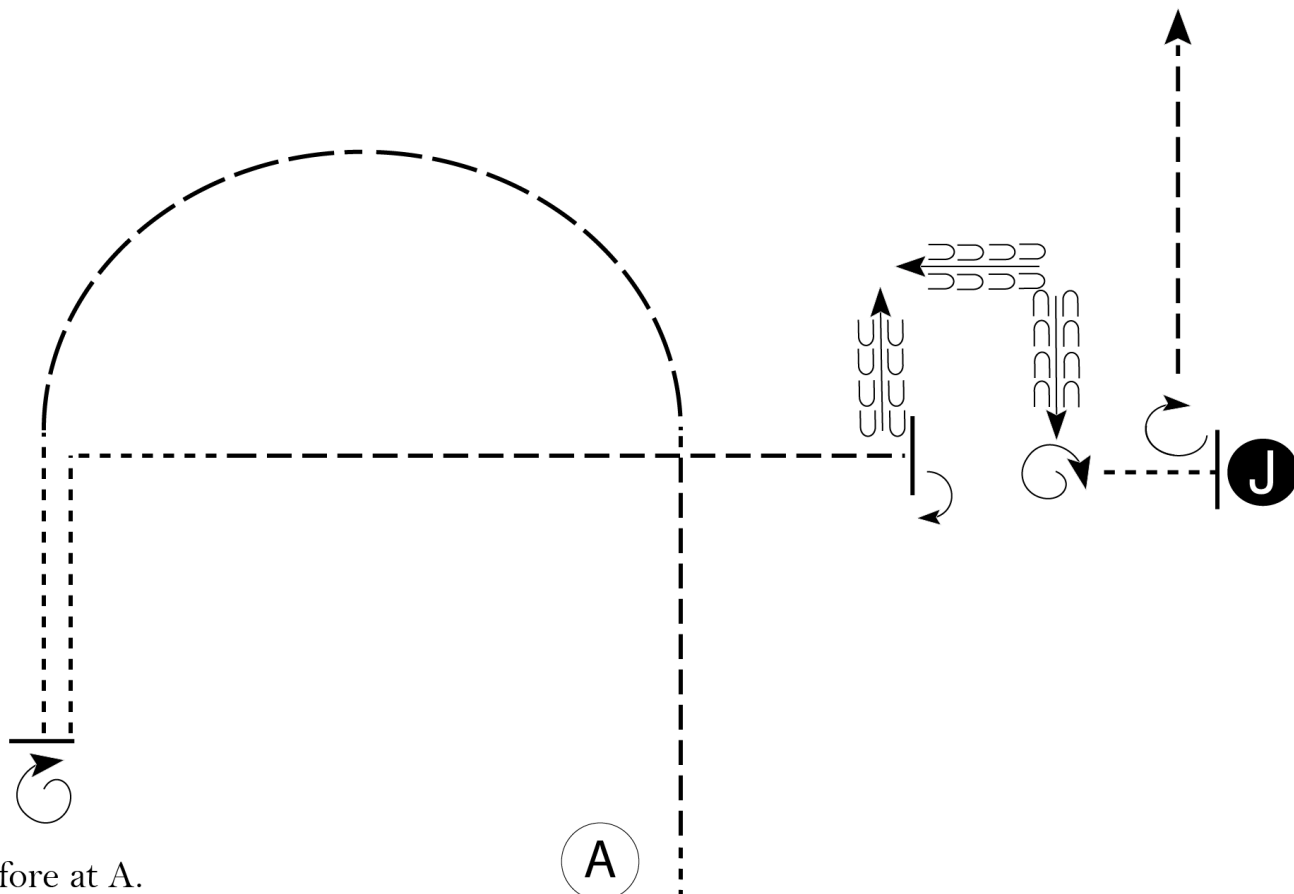

Be before at A.

1. Walk to A. Trot in a straight line then extend the trot in a half circle. Break to a walk and walk 3 strides.
2. Stop and perform a 1 1/2 turn.
3. Set up and present horse.
4. Walk a square corner then trot across center line.
5. Stop, perform a 90 degree turn then back a "U" as shown.
6. Perform a 1 1/4 turn then walk to Judge.
7. Stop and set up for inspection. When dismissed, perform a 3/4 turn and trot straight away.

1. Trot
2. Extended trot
3. Lope left lead
4. Extended trot
5. Walk
6. Lope right lead
7. Trot
8. Extended lope (left lead)
9. Collect lope, change leads (simple or flying), extended lope (right lead), collect lope
10. Trot
11. Left hand push gate into pen
12. Walk over logs
13. Right hand push gate out of pen
14. Walk
15. Stop, 360 degree turn each direction (either direction 1st) (L-R or R-L)
16. Back

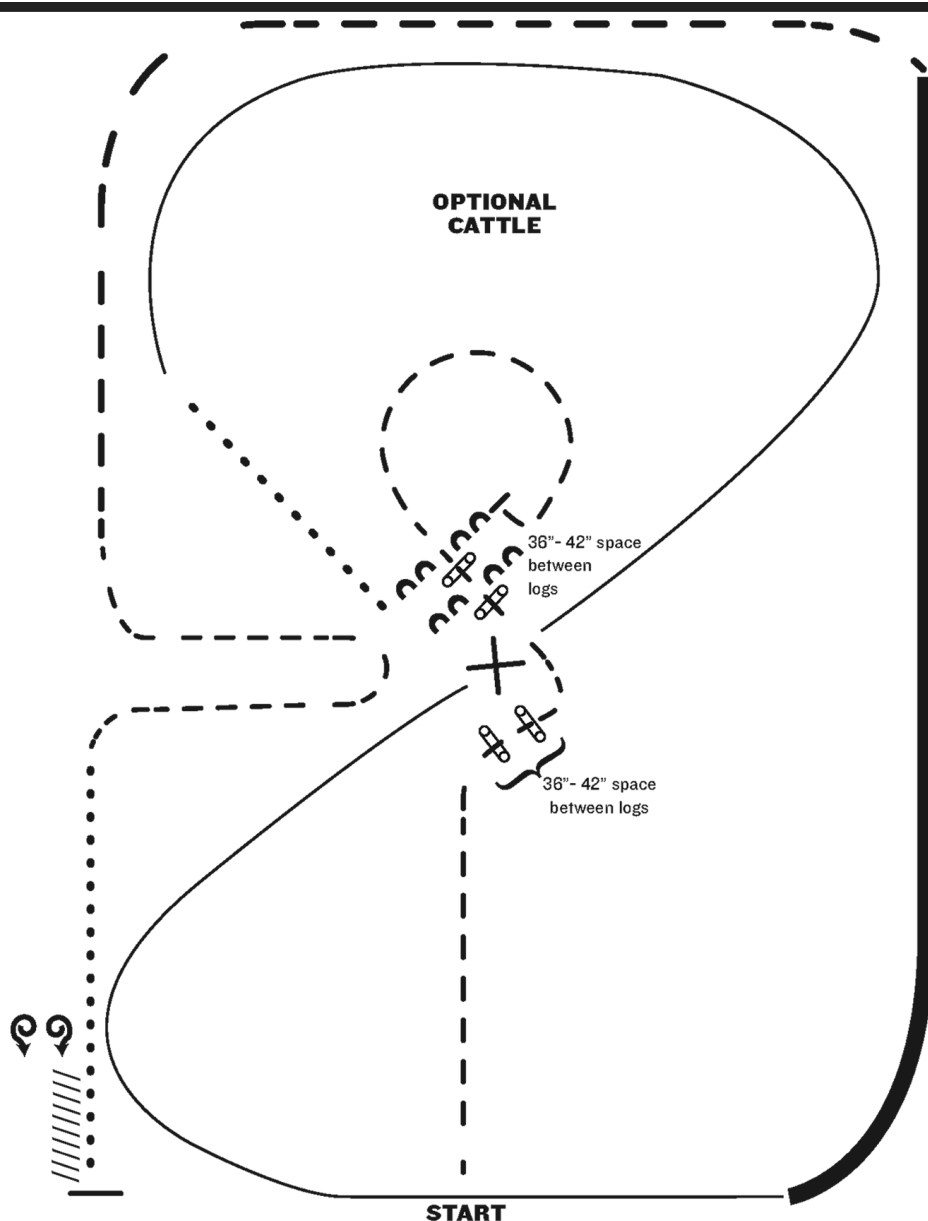

 4. Walk

 6. Change leads (simple or flying)
 7. Lope left lead
 8. Extended lope (left lead)
 9. Extended trot
 10. Trot
 11. Walk
 12. Stop and back
 13. 360 degree turn each direction (either direction 1st) (L-R or R-L)

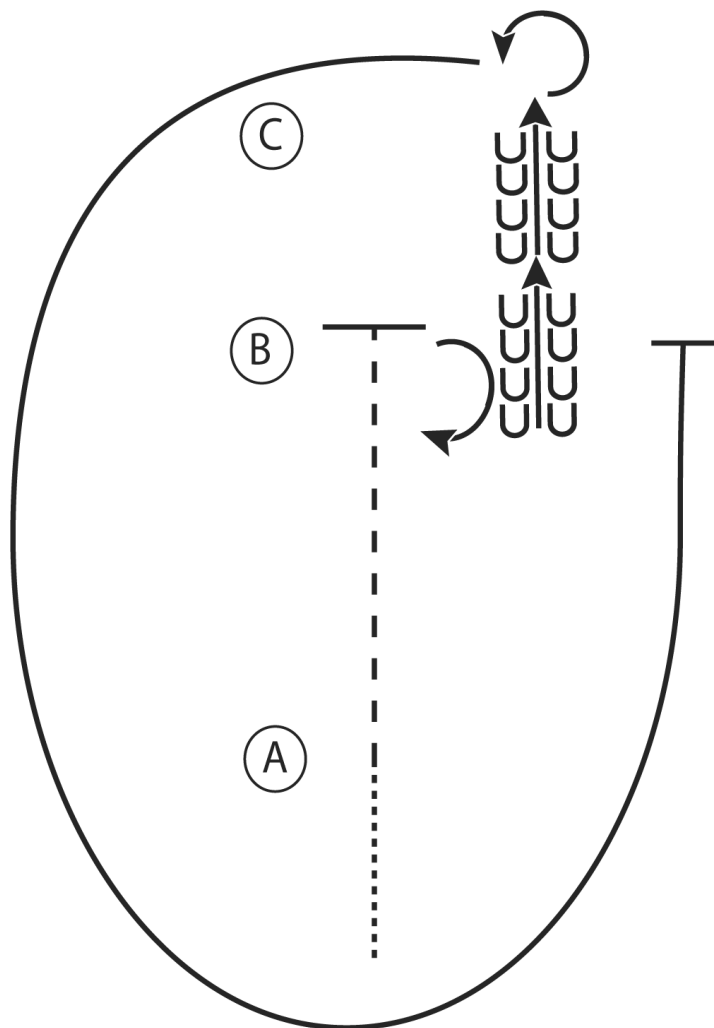

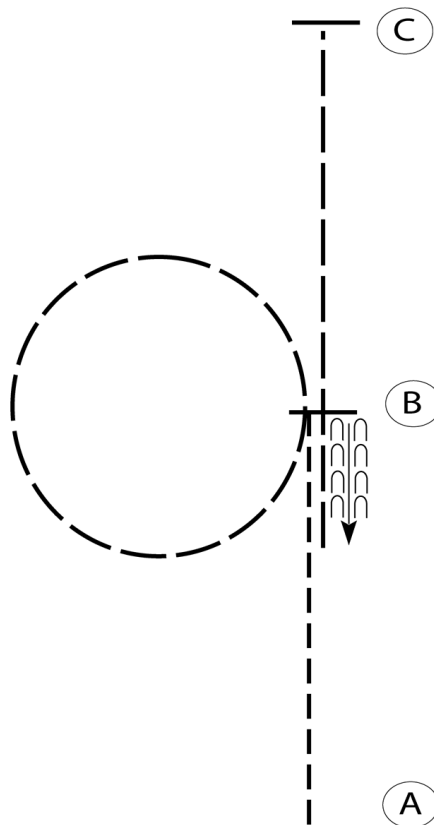
