WSQHA puts on the two largest quarter horse shows on the West Coast and the largest in Washington State. We strive to be innovative and evolve with the rapidly changing times. One commitment remains the same, giving you great exposure to the northwest horse community. If you have visited our website in the past, take the time to revisit our brand-new site launched this January.

We offer a total of eight shows a year. We pride ourselves in offering a variety of classes and dual approvals to be as inclusive as possible. This year, our alliance partners are Lope On In, World Ranch Horse Association, Premier Sires, Southwest Paint Horse Association, Pacific Northwest Paint Horse Club, Northwest Pinto, Cascade Pinto, Northwest Coordinating Committee, American Paint Horse Association, Appaloosa Horse Club, Pinto Association, and the American Quarter Horse Association. This wide range of partnerships offers a huge marketing platform, several breeds, and a successful social media following.

Our stand-alone events showcasing our Ranch and Reining horses were a huge success, and we are excited to expand our partnership with the World Ranch Horse Association. We have expanded our High Point Buckle awards and offer 22 buckles at each Ranch show! We are excited to watch our members' success as they plan to attend the WRHA Championships in Nevada in October.

This year alone, WSQHA awarded over \$25,000 in prize money to our exhibitors. Our awards budget tops \$60,000 a year, and we give over 200 buckles at the NW Emerald alone. Last year, we awarded 22 buckles to our NW Emerald Leadline participants alone.

We continue to support the AQHA Foundation Regional Scholarship. This year, we celebrate 20 years of partnership with AQHA. WSQHA has partnered with Oregon and Alaska to bring you the Region One Scholarship show taking place during our Fiesta Circuit. All proceeds from the Regional classes will go directly to the AQHA Foundation to work towards our third Youth Scholarship for Region One. We are proud to have led the way in over \$270,000 in scholarship funds vested and held in the AQHA Foundation. We are \$28,000 away from vesting a THIRD Scholarship.

New this year is the partnership with the Pacific Northwest Paint Horse Club at our June Trophy Circuit. We have added 4 MORE Harris Saddles for our APHA exhibitors with our 2 All-Breed and 7 AQHA All-Around Saddles. We pride ourselves on being able to share our shows with our fellow stock horse types.

Our show season wraps up at the WS Finals with our stand-alone Level 1 Show. This year, we are excited to partner with Cascade Pinto and NW Pinto to offer a Jubilee and introduce them to our show format in the hopes they will join us in future shows.

Our sponsor packages offer maximum exposure for your dollar. We are also proud to boast that 100% of your donation goes directly to the exhibitors in the way of prize money, awards, or exhibitor parties.
