6. Stop and back one horse length.
7. Pattern is complete. Exit at a sitting trot.

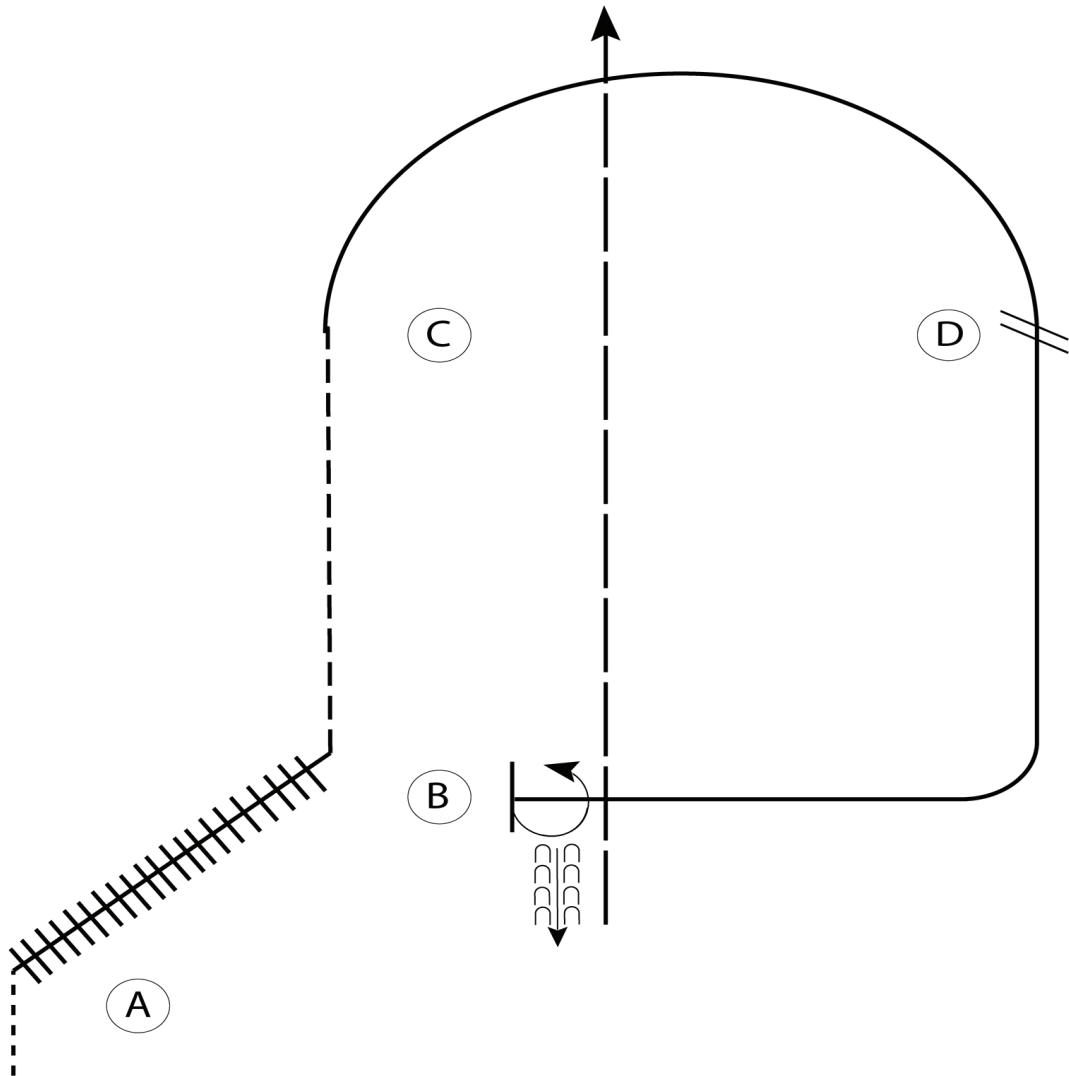

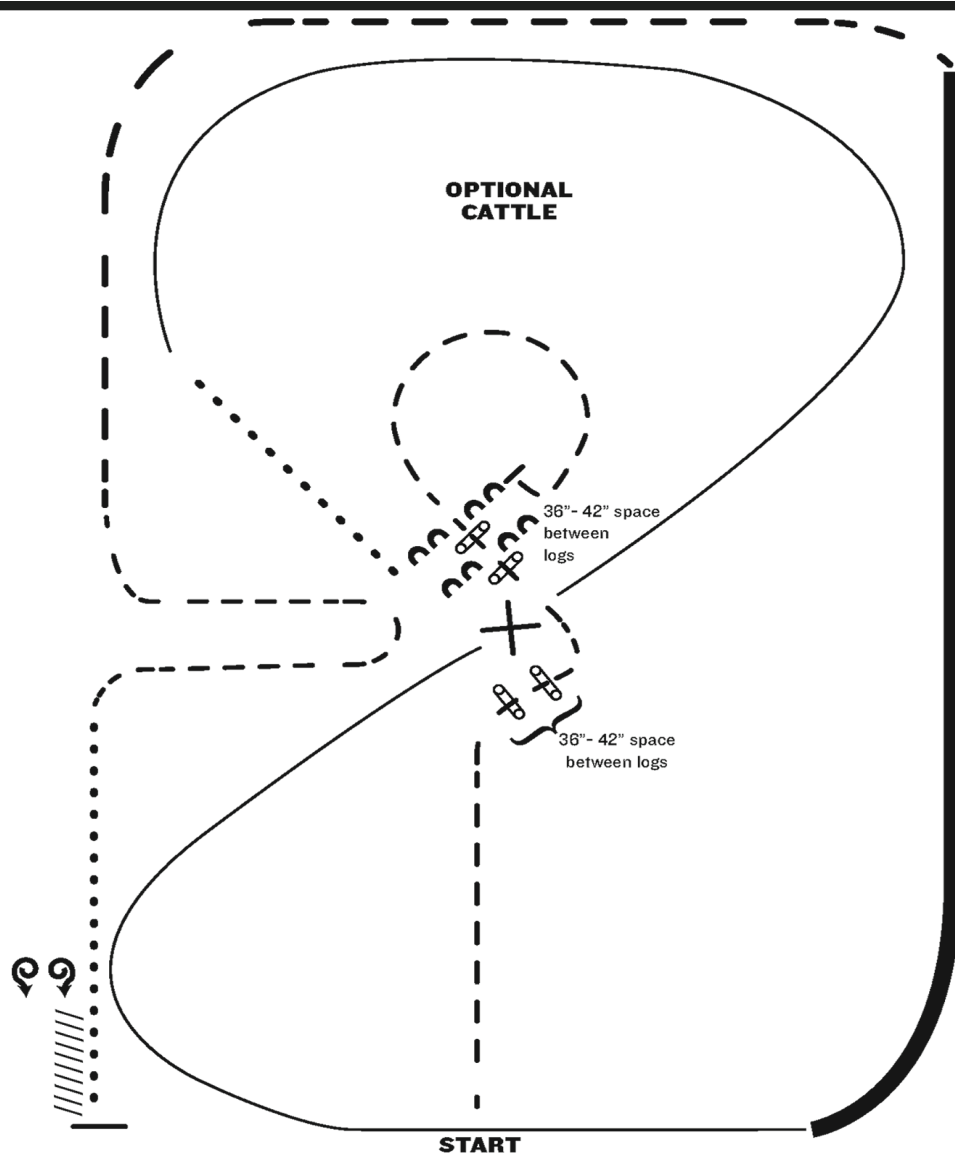

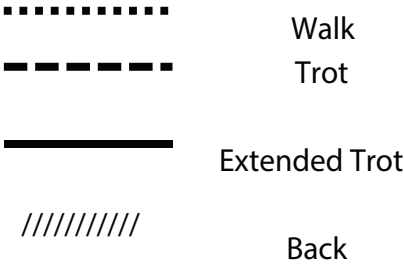
