

## 2026 WSQHA General Ranch Show Rules

**Pre-Entries**—A pre entry constitutes an entry that has been processed online with all the information complete. Registration paper must be presented to the secretary at the time of entry for all registered breed classes. Papers and memberships must be uploaded on line to be considered a pre entry. Pre-entries dates are listed on the class list. The office fee shall be charged at time of entry and is non refundable. FAXES AND MESSENGER ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

**Post-Entries**—A \$25 one time post entry fee will be added if entries are received after the entry date. Post entry fee does not apply to pre-entered horses who add classes at the show.

**AQHA Performance Halter**—You must provide proof of eligibility ROM in order to participate in Performance Halter or show in one walk, jog, lope or canter performance class under the same show number

**APHA Performance Halter**—Horses one year of age and older. Horses are not eligible to compete in other classes as listed in APHA Rule SC-175 at the same show or contest. Horses must compete in a minimum of one performance class other than showmanship at the same show to be eligible. APHA Rule SC170 M1

**AQHA Membership**—Anyone wishing to show in an AQHA class must present a current AQHA membership card at the time of entry. Membership can be purchased at the office. An internet receipt from AQHA will NOT be accepted as proof.

**Adds and Scratches**—Scratches may only be made through the on line app and must be at least three classes prior to the class you are scratching. All other scratches will be charged. All closed accounts will not receive a refund. You must add your classes for each day online at the show app.

**Stall Reservations**—Stalls are not guaranteed or assigned if not done in line with complete payment. Groups wishing to be stabled together MUST PAY FOR ALL STALLS. Please upload a stall list form with everyone wishing to be stabled together. Please no phone reservations. Stalls must be vacated and left in a reasonable manner. Any paraphernalia left in stall assigned to you shall constitute a \$100.00 fine. **Stall fees are non refundable.**

**Refund of Entry**—Refunds are only granted if an official Veterinary slip is presented before the start of the first class of the entire show to the show office. Once the Vet slip is received, a \$40.00 office fee per entry and stall shall be deducted and a refund shall be mailed. Stalls are non refundable.

**Fines Levied**—Please be aware that exhibitors are responsible for fines levied against the show caused by exhibitor. See Rule 414c in the AQHA Handbook.

**NSF Fees**—A \$35.00 NSF fee shall be added to all payment that are not sufficient.

**Open Accounts**—Accounts that are not settled before the end of the show shall incur an additional **\$20.00 collection fee**. Please be sure all accounts are settled within 30 minutes of the last class of the show or the office will settle your account for you.

**Accounts**-All accounts are considered final after 7 days. Any question on charges must be presented within 7 days of the shows completion.

**Draws**—All class draws shall be done at least two classes prior and posted on line. All late entries shall be placed at the end of the draw.

**Drug Testing**—All horses entering AQHA classes and Futurities are subject to approved drug testing.

**Awards**—Circuit awards and ribbons shall be given through 5 places in all classes. Check Individual shows for specialty awards.

**Walk/Trot**—Please review AQHA and WRHA WalkTrot cross entry rules.

**All Breed**—These classes are meant to encourage and bring new members to our association.

**High Points**—All classes in your division including halter will count towards the Performance High Points listed on the show schedule. Ties will be broke by the horse with the most first, then the horse that places the most times and if still tied by coin toss. You must show in 3 classes to be eligible for a high point in both circuits. Any questions on high point standings must be addressed at the show within an hour of the last class, after that time all standings will remain as presented.

**Right to Service** - The show management reserves the right to refuse service for any reason. This is a closed event and the management reserves the right to remove anyone from the grounds for any reason. Dogs are not allowed in the arena and schooling areas due to the extreme danger to injury to horse and riders.

**Conditions**—The conditions of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the AQHA, APHA, WSQHA and SWWPHC general rules. The final right to settle all questions or disputes is reserved for the show management. Exhibitors, Trainers, Riders or any other participant gives unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agrees in advance to be bound thereby.

**Novice Amateurs** must present current year Nov Am cards or complete an application for same and submit to the show secretary before entry into the class is allowed. A reminder that APHA rules state that only horses owned by the Am or Nov Am can be shown, Rule AM-020. Amateurs 19 and over are allowed to exhibit multiple horses in group classes
